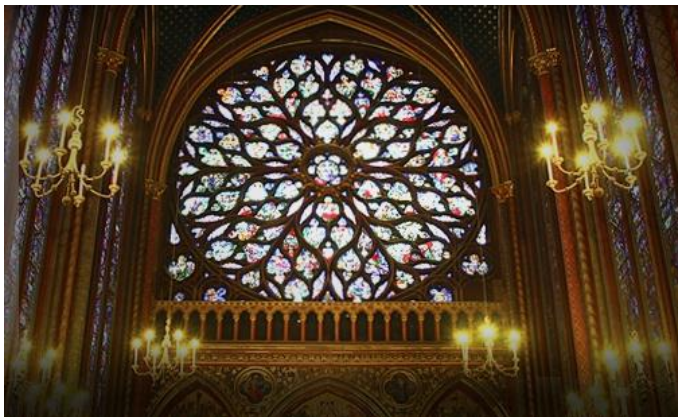

The 2012 Annual Catholic Appeal is underway. Many of our parishioners either have or soon will receive a mailing from Cardinal George. He will ask you to make a pledge to the 2012 *Annual Catholic Appeal*. Please respond generously.

The Appeal supports both parish and Archdiocesan ministries. Among these are ministries that provide religious education to children, youth and adults. It is also one of the largest philanthropic sources of financial support for Catholic schools in the Archdiocese. The Appeal funds services that are of great help to the ministries here in our parish.

Special Benefit to St. Terrence Parish

When our parish reaches its goal of **\$23,240.00** in paid pledges, 100% of the additional funds received will be returned to us for use in our parish. In previous years, we have met that goal and received a rebate that paid for the new partitions in the Father Riordan Center.

This year we are looking at replacing the carillon system. The outside bells have not worked for many months. We are also looking into replacement of the Church light fixtures with more energy efficient lighting. You may have noticed that the lights in church are burning out quickly because many of the original fixtures are broken. Currently, we have 92 bulbs at 500 watts per bulb.

This year, the theme of the Appeal is: *"Be imitators of Christ."* We are all challenged to try to live our lives using the life of Christ as an example. Christ gave us the path to eternal life. His love for each of us cannot be taken lightly.

As we contemplate His gifts to us, we should also reflect on our gratitude for these gifts. Your financial support for the work of our parish, of our Archdiocese, and of our Church throughout the world is, in fact, one way to express this gratitude.

Please prayerfully consider making a significant pledge to the 2012 Annual Catholic Appeal. The Announcement weekend is next weekend, February 4-5, 2012. The actual pledge weekend is February 11-12. God bless you for your generosity.

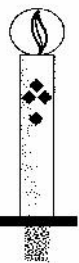

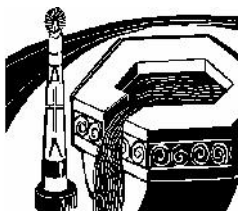

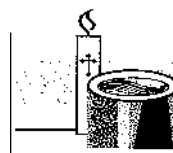
